

## Accepting Feedback

### *What is feedback?*

*Feedback is advice that helps me get better at something.*

*Sometimes feedback tells me what I did well, and sometimes it tells me what I can improve.*

### *How do I accept feedback?*

- *I listen to the person giving me feedback.*
- *I stay calm, even if I feel upset.*
- *I can say: "Thank you for telling me."*
- *I can ask a question if I don't understand.*
- *I can try the suggestion to get better.*

5. Your friend said, "I like working in a group with you, but sometimes I didn't get a turn to share my ideas."
6. Mom said, "I'm proud of how you cleaned your room. Next time, don't forget under the bed."
7. Mom said, "You helped set the table. Next time, check that everyone has a fork."
8. Dad said, "You played nicely with your sister, but try not to grab toys from her."
9. Mr. Rudy said, "You did great answering these scenarios, but you rushed through the last one."
